What is a typical week like at Created for a Purpose?

- One-week, Day Camp structure
(Sessions are typically 9:00 am to 1:30 pm;
Afternoon sessions could be 2:30 - 7:00 pm or 3:00 - 7:30pm)
- Girls are divided into groups according to age and grade
- Each day begins with worship: singing, dancing, praise, prayer
- Girls start and complete a different creative project each day: sewing, painting, cooking, paper, sculpture
- Women of all ages have the opportunity to serve together. High school and college girls serve as counselors, as well as teach and assist with projects.
- At the end of the week, parents are invited to an Art Show where all the campers' art is showcased in the project rooms and church common areas.

Why do we need to come to Birmingham for Training?

- We structure our in-person, hands-on training to take you and your leaders through the format of a Created for a Purpose camp! This allows you to experience and learn along with ladies from other churches, just like girls experience the ministry!
- At training, we review the summer spiritual curriculum, walk through and complete a variety of art projects, present best practices for food preparation, and give you the logistical tools helpful to offering this ministry in an organized way.
- We include new materials and projects every year, and the added benefits are: the food is delicious, the fellowship encouraging, and we make it SUPER FUN! We believe that attending Training equips your church with the tools you need to run a one-week Created for a Purpose program.

How much does it cost to offer Created for a Purpose at my church?

LICENSING/TRAINING COST:

- The annual cost of licensing Created for a Purpose is \$500.00. This includes:
 - Registration for up to 3 people to attend Training
 - Additional attendees are \$100.00 per person
 - Licensing allows a host church to offer week-long Created for a Purpose camps, as well as Christmas Workshop, within a 12 month period, as many times as you would like!

PER CAMPER COSTS:

- We estimate that operational costs are approximately \$190-\$200 per child who participates in Created for a Purpose. \$50 of this total is billed by/paid to Created for a Purpose Ministries to cover the expenses of items that each camper receives: a t-shirt, devotional guide, cookbook, memory verse card, and tote bag. These items are produced by Created for a Purpose Ministries and align with the spiritual curriculum for that summer. Additional expenses (\$140-150 per camper) include:
 - Art project supplies and cost of food
 - Administrative and organizational supplies
 - Any payment you choose to make to coordinators
- These per camper costs would be covered by the camp registration fee. If scholarships are offered, Created for a Purpose Ministries does not charge the \$50 per camper fee for those campers' materials. The per camper cost can vary based on your facilities and local food prices.

What resources do licensed churches receive?

- Once you have registered for Training Workshop and paid the yearly licensing fee, you will receive access to the Church Resource Page hosted on our website. This page includes digital resources such as graphics, social media templates, and other useful tools to help promote your camp. We will also add your program location and dates to our website, as well as a link to your online registration page.
- You will receive two printed manuals at Training: an overall Logistics Manual and a Spiritual Curriculum/Project manual with the memory verse, teaching prompts, and art projects we recommend implementing.
- Within the manuals and website resources, you will have access to:
 - Recorded Daily Talks outlining our Spiritual Curriculum
 - Our Vimeo page with project resources/how-to videos
 - Our suggested Weekly Menu, with recipes & ingredients and grocery list for 50
 - Project ideas/directions/supply lists for project areas
 - Sample schedule
 - Cost analysis/budget
 - Counselor Training Resources
